## TRANSPORT & GENERAL WORKS UNION CASE STUDY

The Transport and General Works Union (TGWU) is the UK's largest general union with over 800,000 members throughout the UK and Ireland. The union aims to represent members of the workforce and improve their rights and conditions. The TGWU has been using BT's Meridian telephone system for a number of years and has found its services insufficient, inflexible and expensive to run and maintain.

### LARGE MULTI SITE REQUIREMENT
